

But it was in the role of mentor that Ron truly changed lives; helping actors not only become various characters, but also teaching them how to build character within themselves. THE SPRINGER IS ADJACENT TO "MOTHER TOWN" COWETA AND "DAUGHTER TOWN" CUSSETA, TWO ANCIENT CENTERS OF MUSCOGEE CULTURE.


